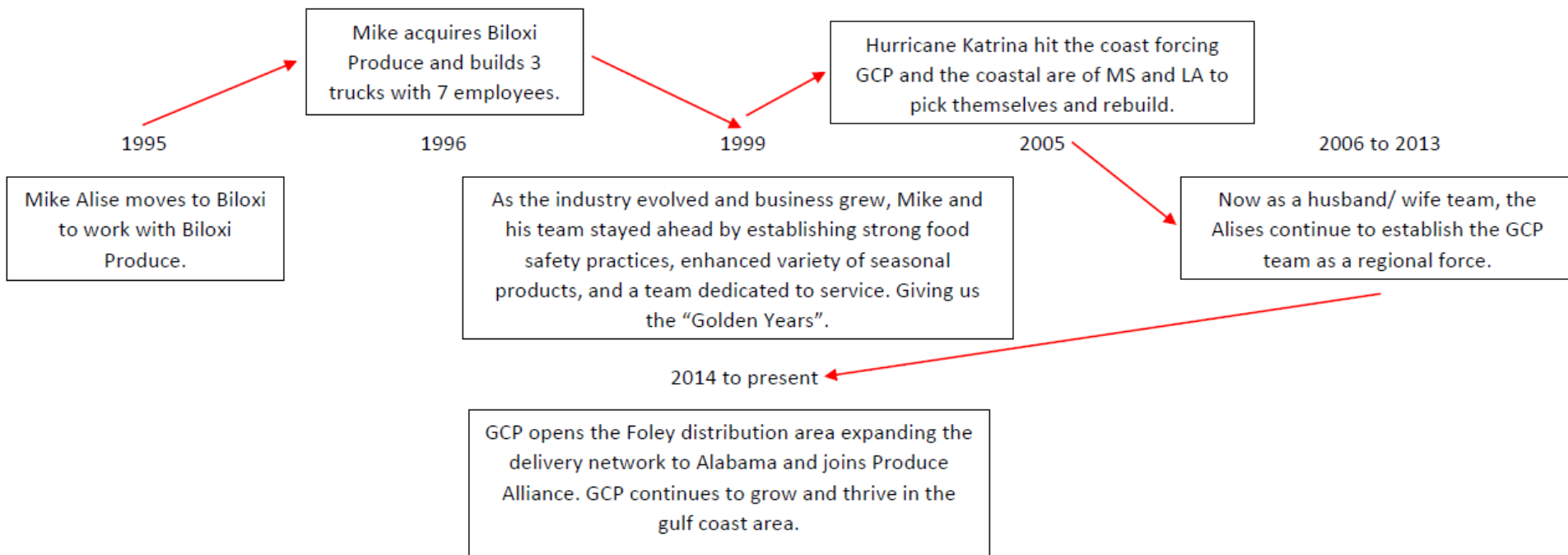

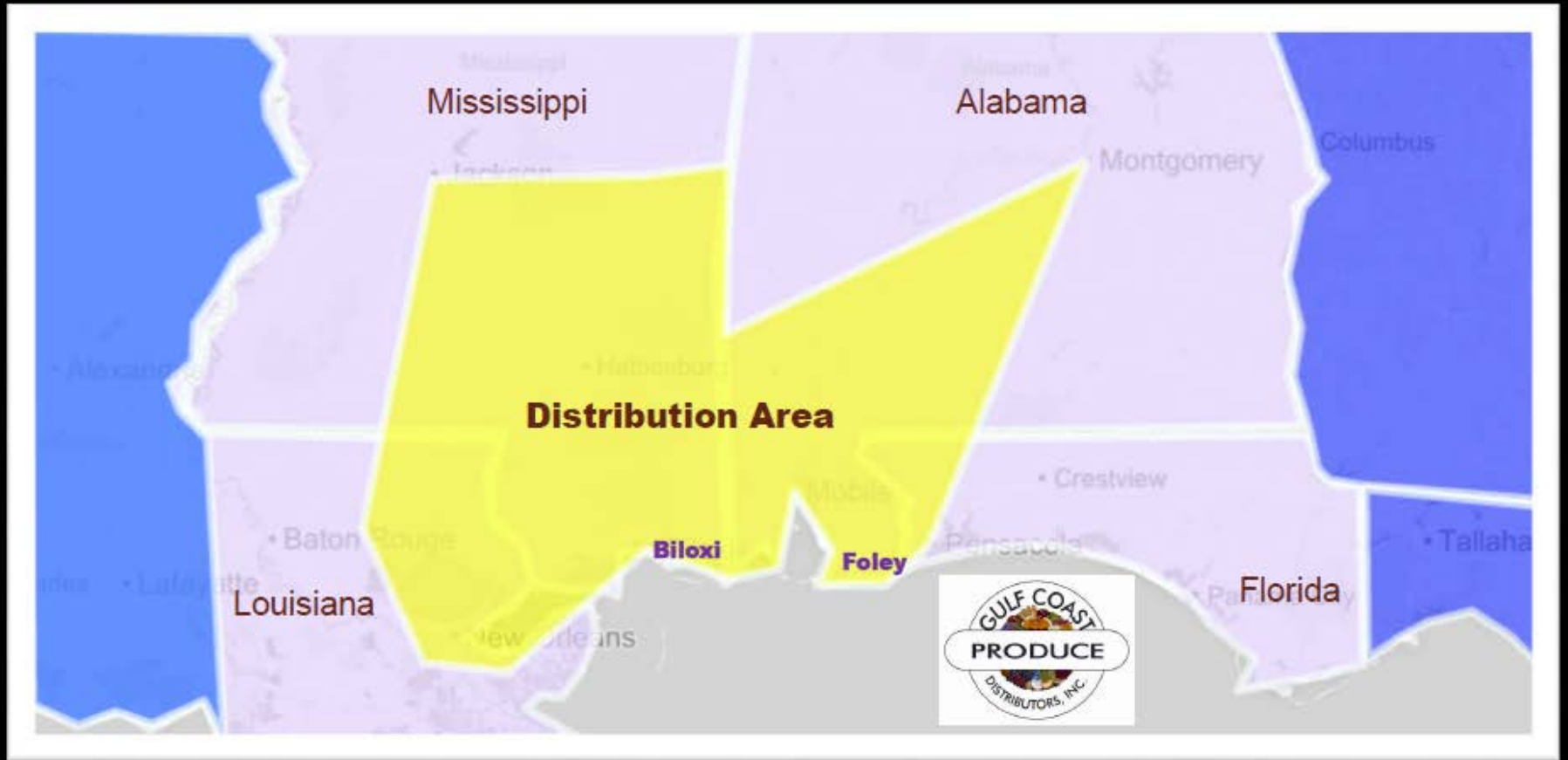

Distribution Map



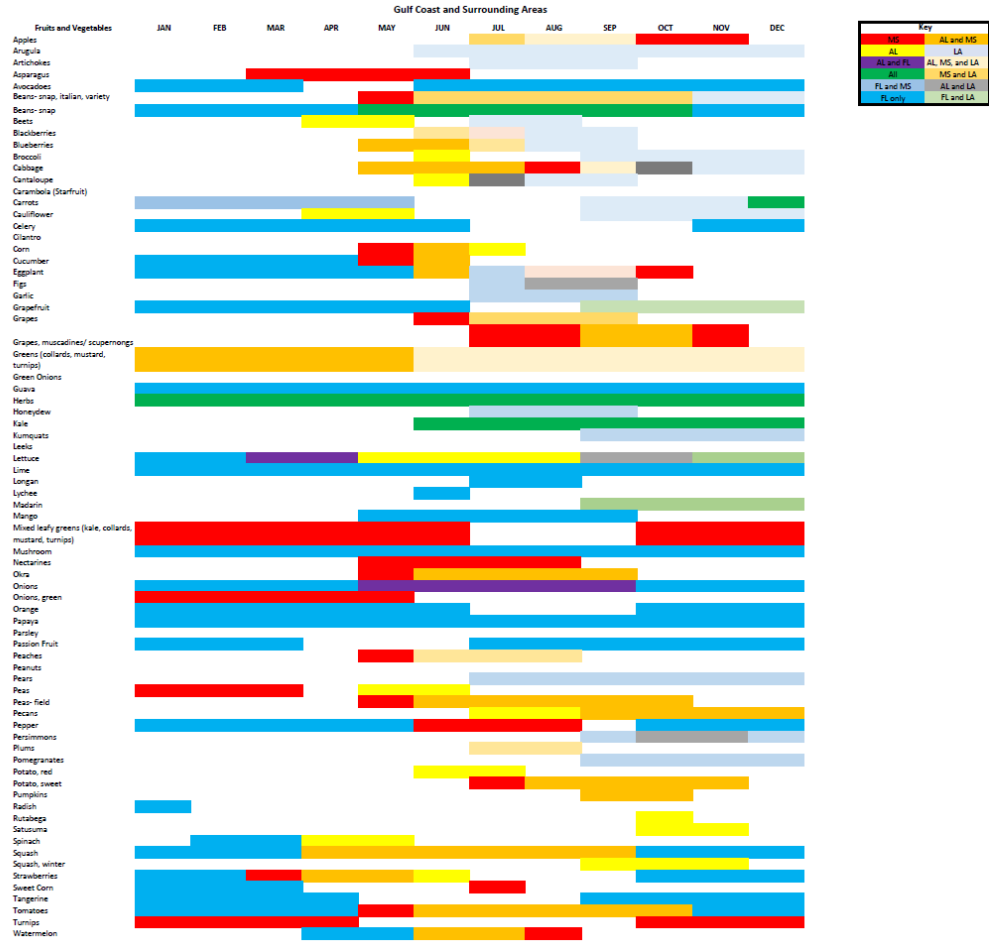
